- Promote the creation of community food security
- Support the creation of model areas for community food reservation, learning center on food security and knowledge management, through collection and lessons learnt from action taken in various areas.

Promote and support policy planning on use of areas at various levels and plans on land use in the planning and requirements thereof designed to enhance the benefits of agricultural areas, public areas, wasteland, and vacant areas, including reserving abundant areas that can be used as food security areas in times of crisis.

Prescribe tax measures, compensation or other measures to create opportunity and Incentives for the private sector, community and public agencies with vacant areas to use or be allowed to use idle areas for food security in crises in a non-profit manner.

Prepare local development plans or community plans or community health charter to create food security from the community food base so that the community is able to self-manage food in crises.

Study and propose to the government the creation of mechanisms and food reservation system in preparation for crises at national and local levels

Study the feasibility of

- Issuing announcements and orders to empower local government organizations to use the budget and resources to rake action when there are food security problems in times if crisis.
- Provision of funding sources that community organizations and people sector can get access to recover from the crisis.

There are more food product price control measures in times of crisis

A system to prevent and control food hoarding in times of crisis is developed:

- Increased penalty in legal provisions
- Social measures of the community.
- There are activities and projects to promote the creation of community food security.
- There are projects and action taken on knowledge management, including creation of learning centers in various areas.

Action is taken to develop policy planning on use of areas at various levels and plans prescribing land use for food security in crises as follows:

- Development of policy and action plans
- Preparation and publicity of action guidelines
- Review of plans of various areas.

Vacant or not-in-use areas are used for the purposes of food security in crises.

There is a local development plan or community plan or community health charter to create food security from the community base.

- There are research findings and recommendations to the government.
- Action is taken to set up mechanisms and develop food reservation system in crises at national and local levels.
- There are research findings and recommendations
- There are announcements and orders allowing local government organizations .to administer the budget and resources to solve food security problems in crises.
- Action is taken to develop funding sources.

In times of crisis all people can get access to food at a fair price.

Each community sees continuous development in line with its special context, ensuring its food security ready for the crisis.

Urban and community developments make appropriate use of space and areas ready for food security for every citizen and for every crisis.
