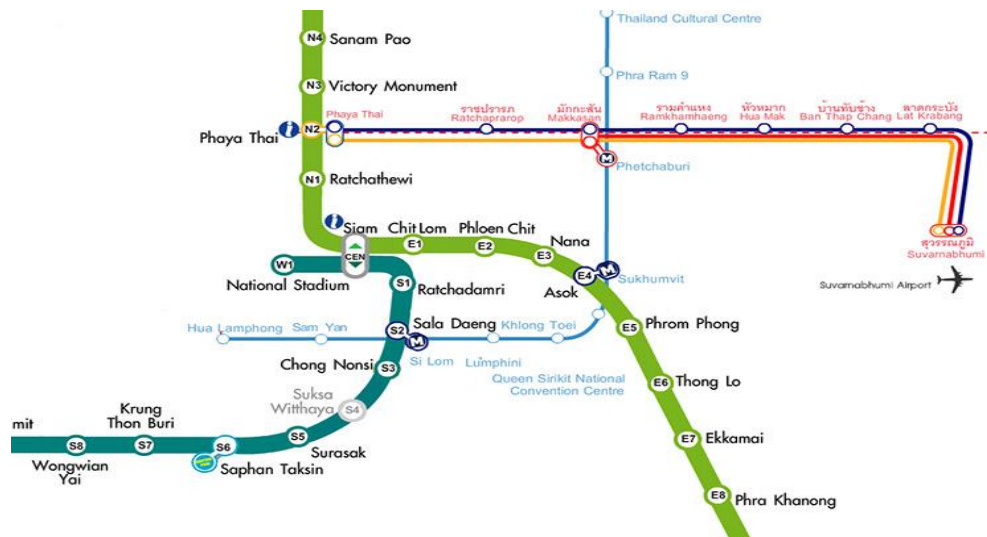
How to go to Hotel

Drop at Chidlom Station (E1 at exit4), walk toward “Soi Tonson” and enter the alley about 50 meters.

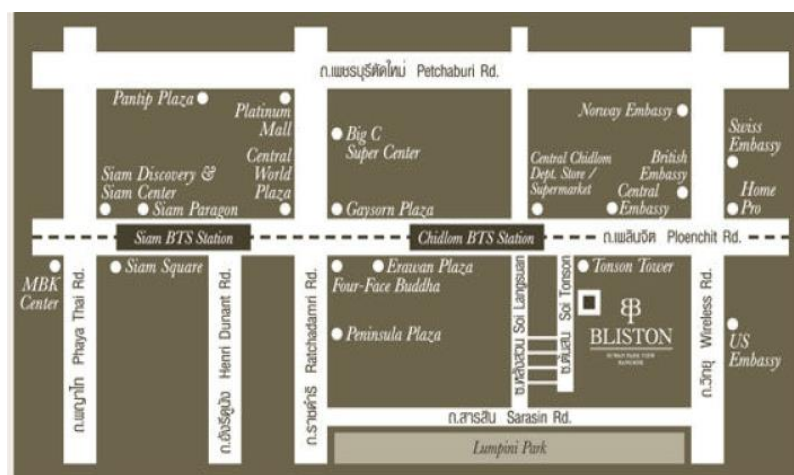

Take the public taxi and ask the driver to “Bliston Suwan Park View Hotel” which is located at Soi Tonson, Pleonchit Road. The hotel is opposite to Central Chidlom Department Store. Enter the alley about 50 meters. Bliston building is on your left hand side.

COVID-19 Protection Guideline

All the participants who attend the workshop will be required to consider the precautionary measures during the workshop as provided below.
