

Thailand Health Governance by Partnership

The establishment of institutes for health system development in Thailand

Healthcare Accreditation Institute (Public Organization)(HAI)

Established by the royal decree of 2009, HAI operates the assessment of work systems and the accreditation of healthcare organizations, including setting out standards of healthcare organizations that can be used as a guideline for assessing quality improvement and certify the quality of service of hospitals.

National Institute of Emergency Medicine (NIEM)

Established by the Emergency Medicine Act in 2008 to regulate and strengthen the emergency medical services system of Thailand. Governed by the Emergency Medical Service Board with the Minister of Public Health as a chairperson.

Health Intervention and Technology Assessment Program (HITAP)

A semi-autonomous organization under MoPH. Established in 2007 to take responsibility for appraising a wide range of health technologies and programs, including pharmaceuticals, medical devices, interventions, individual and community health promotion, and disease prevention as well as social health policy to inform policy decisions in Thailand.

National Health Security Office (NHSO)

Established in 2002, under the National Health Security Act, the NHSO is governed by the National Security Health Board, led by the Public Health Minister. Dedicated to achieving UHC for all, it ensures confidence in accessing quality healthcare through its commitment to accessible services, financial sustainability, and good governance.

Thai Health Promotion Foundation (ThaiHealth)

Established by the Health Promotion Foundation Act in 2001 to support health promotion movement. ThaiHealth receives revenue from a surcharged 2 percent of the excise taxes on tobacco and alcohol products. As such, ThaiHealth utilizes its innovative and sustainable funds to strategically support health promotion programs/projects by the multi-sectoral Board of Governance, chaired by the Prime Minister.

International Health Policy Program, Thailand (IHPP)

Established in 2001, IHPP aims at improving health and well-being of people by generating reliable knowledge and evidence on health policy and systems for the public and policy makers. IHPP also focuses on building up capacity of Thai young researchers through hand-on experience and postgraduate studies.

Health Systems Research Institute (HSRI)

Established by the Health Systems Research Institute Act in 1992, HSRI has an overarching goal to achieve effective knowledge management by conducting research system for developing policies leading to good health for all.

Ministry of Public Health (MoPH)

Established in 1918, MoPH is the health authority of Thailand responsible for oversight of health services and public health in Thailand. The majority of hospitals are operated by MoPH. Its overall roles are policy development, implementing, supervising, monitoring, and evaluation for the good health of population.

National Health Commission Office (NHCO)

Established by the National Health Act in 2007, NHCO develops and drives policy recommendations by the participatory public policy process based on wisdom. NHCO creates platforms such as the National and Provincial Health Assemblies for consultation and collaboration. Governed by the multisectoral National Health Commission, which is chaired by the Prime Minister.
