3. HOW TO GO TO BEST WESTERN CHATUCHAK, BANGKOK

From Suvarnabhumi Airport

By Airport Rail Link sky train + BTS or taxi

- Airport Rail link Suvarnabhumi Airport station heading to Phayathai station about 45 minutes = 45 THB
- Change to BTS Sukhumvit Line heading to Kheha -Khu Khot station to Saphan Khwai Station (Exit 3), and travel by BTS sky train or TAXI



By Taxi

Ask the driver to Best Western Chatuchak Hotel located at

18 Kamphaeng Phet road, Chatuchak and opposite to OR TOR KOR market

<u>Please note</u> that taxi fare from airport will have an **additional 50 THB** (service fee), pay directly to driver. If you have more than 1 luggage, there is extra charge at 20 THB/luggage.




From Don Mueang International Airport

By A1 Bangkok's shuttle bus

(A1 NGV: Don Mueang Airport - Mochit (Expressway))

- Bus will be wait at gate number 6 and take time to Mo Chit BTS station about 30 minutes/ 30 THB
- 2. Bus ends at Opposite Chatuchak Market (Gate 1)
- 3. Walk to Best Western Chatuchak Bangkok





By public transportation




By MRT sky train: Kampheang Phet Station (Exit 1)

- 1. Turn right your hand side and walk straight to hotel
- 2. Best western building is on your right hand side opposite to OR TOR KOR market



By BTS sky train: Saphan Khwai Station (Exit 3)

- Walk straight heading to Kampheang Phet junction or Chatuchak park about 1 km/10-15 minutes
- 2. Cross the road carefully and turn your left hand side
- Walk straight to hotel about 190 meters/3 minutes, Best western building is on your right hand side opposite to OR TOR KOR market
